

The Edit is a Post Production facility based in the heart of Brighton. We have 19 full-time staff and various freelance clients working at our premises. We are constantly reviewing and improving our policies to reduce our impact on the environment, with a focus on energy consumption and waste.

Travel

- Many of our staff and clients live locally and commute via walking or cycling. Others use public transport with only a handful of people driving in from further away.

Energy

- Our Electricity and Gas is supplied by Good Energy, using 100% renewable electricity, whilst actively reducing their own carbon emissions. All air conditioning units are set to a timed schedule and are turned off in any unoccupied edit suites.

- All lights are turned off in any unoccupied edit suites and all communal corridors use light sensors that automatically turn off when not sensing any movement. We use the 'Eco' or '90 minute' dishwasher cycles and only put these on once the machines are completely full.

Waste

- Correspondence with clients and staff is paperless including quotations, invoicing and onboarding. We ask clients to print only when absolutely necessary and we recycle all paper when printing is unavoidable. Our printer cartridges are returned and re-filled by the Collected by Lexmark scheme (www.collectedbylexmark.com/program)

- The vast majority of our content is now delivered digitally. We rarely use tape, hard drive or DVDs which require couriers for delivery. If clients request physical mediums, we try to persuade them that digital delivery is more convenient and greener.

- We recycle everything we can and encourage our clients to do the same. We have recycling and glass bins located in the main kitchens and tech support room to encourage recycling where possible.

- We use recycled paper towels in all our toilets.

- Our weekly Rubbish collections are provided by The Recycling Partnership (recyclingpartnership.co.uk), a local zero waste to landfill company, who are committed to finding innovative ways to process waste.

- Plastic bottles and cups are actively discouraged. We provide glass water bottles and glasses to use whilst in the office. Staff are also encouraged to use their own metal water bottles.

Suppliers

- Our cleaners use environmentally friendly cleaning products from sustainable brand Jangro (www.jangro.net) The Enviro range of chemicals is formulated to ensure the impact is kept to an absolute minimum and has been designed to comply with all current European Regulations concerning biodegradability and the preservation of the environment.

- We use Fairtrade, ethically sourced coffee from local family run coffee roasters Back Yard Coffee (www.backyardcoffee.co.uk) Sustainability is key to them and is demonstrated by their various ongoing projects to support social, economic and environmental stability.
